



PUBLIC NOTICE – Public Hearings on Proposed City Charter Revisions

The **Oakridge City Council** will hold 2 Public Hearings on the proposed revisions to the Oakridge City Charter on **Thursday July 11, 2024 at 6pm** and **Thursday July 18, 2024 at 5pm**. A *separate* Charter amendment regarding possible districting of the city will also be considered and discussed. All of the proposed changes to the Charter were made by the Charter Review Subcommittee, which met in public meetings for over 2 years between January 2022 and June 2024. Additionally, *separate* draft resolution to refer a ballot measure ordinance to voters on STAR Voting will also be considered and discussed. The purpose of these hearings is to discuss and gather input from the public on the proposed Charter amendments, as well as the proposed STAR Voting ballot measure.

After the Public Hearings have been held, City Council will meet again on August 1st at 6pm to make a recommendation on sending the final version of the proposed new City Charter, the separate Charter amendment on districting, and the STAR Voting ballot measure ordinance to voters to decide during the November 2024 general election.
